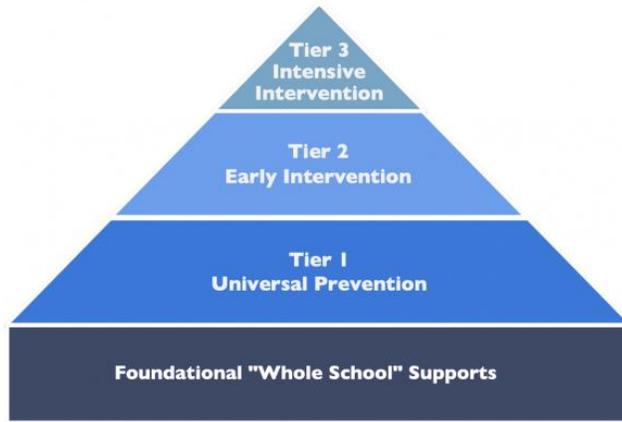

<h3 style="text-align: center;">Tier II</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meets the needs of 5-10% of the student population.</li> <li>• Provides early intervention for students who need more support to avoid chronic absence.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First Notices and School Attendance Improvement Plan</li> <li>• Goal Setting</li> <li>• Incentives</li> <li>• Attendance Tracking Spreadsheet Updated Weekly</li> <li>• Increased Outreach to Families by Attendance Team</li> <li>• Check &amp; Connect /Lunch Bunch</li> <li>• Home Visits or Family Meetings</li> </ul>
<h3 style="text-align: center;">Tier I</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meets needs of 80-90% of the student population.</li> <li>• Represents universal strategies to encourage good attendance for all students.</li> </ul> <p><b>*All students will receive Tier I interventions and supports.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Positive Attendance Messaging through Morning Announcements, School Marquee, Bulletin Boards, Morning Meeting, Teacher Communication, Parent Square, Facebook, Schoology, Mailings, etc.</li> <li>• SWPBIS: Procedures, Routines, Expectations</li> <li>• Positive Relationships Between Students and Adults (2 minutes a day for 10 consecutive days!)</li> <li>• Culturally Responsive Practices</li> <li>• Social Emotional Curriculum: Social Skill Teaching, Safe, Positive and Welcoming Environment</li> <li>• Equity for All Students</li> <li>• Partnerships with District, City and State Agencies and Services</li> <li>• Incentives: Class Perfect Attendance, Strive for Five, Monthly Class Competitions, Perfect Attendance Breakfasts</li> <li>• Family and Student Engagement Opportunities</li> <li>• Student Wellness Checks, Connectivity to Peers and Caring Adults</li> <li>• Facilitate Access to Basic Needs (Connect with CSD)</li> <li>• Regular Monitoring of Attendance Data to Activate Supports and Identify Trends</li> <li>• Personalized Outreach When Students are Absent (Phone calls, Post Cards)</li> <li>• Recognition of Good and Improved Attendance</li> <li>• Community Building to Create Belonging and Connection (i.e. Morning Meeting)</li> </ul>
