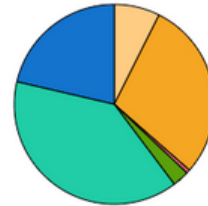

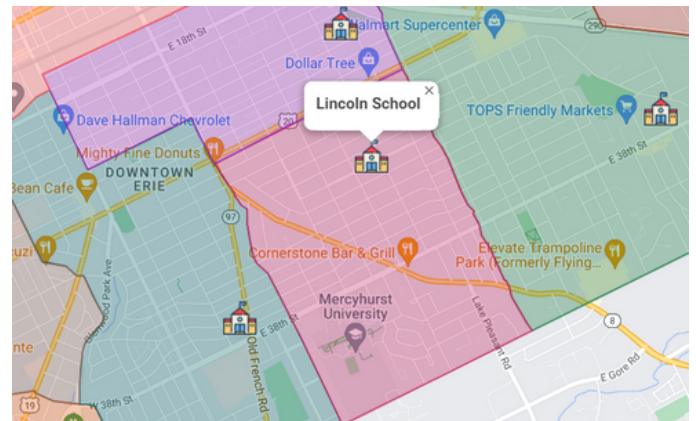

RESOURCES, PROGRAMS, PARTNERSHIPS

The 2023-2024 school year was Lincoln's second full school year as a community school. Several new initiatives for students and staff were launched.

- Each grade level received \$700 in curriculum-aligned enrichment funding through United Way. Each related arts teacher received \$400. Teachers could opt to go on a field trip or bring enrichment to the school.
- Each quarter there were two after school programs available to students in grades 3-5. Programs this year included Lake Erie Arboretum at Frontier, Garden Club, Wellness with White Pine, Small Bites with Common Threads, Yoga with Danielle Kudlak, and Sculpture with Erie Arts and Culture.
- Family engagement events - including Trunk or Treat and Lincoln's end-of-year Family Safari Night.
- A fifth grade student ambassador group developing leaders at Lincoln Elementary.
- United Way funding also supported the community closet to help meet the basic needs of students and families so they can focus on learning.
- All Lincoln staff and students received a Lincoln t-shirt to welcome them back for the new school year.
- A monthly \$25 gift card raffle for staff and Teacher Appreciation Week events.
